

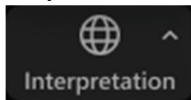
## How to Set Up your Device to Listen to Language Interpretation in Zoom

To listen to language interpretation, first join the Zoom meeting. The original language will be English. If you want to listen in English, you do not need to use language interpretation.

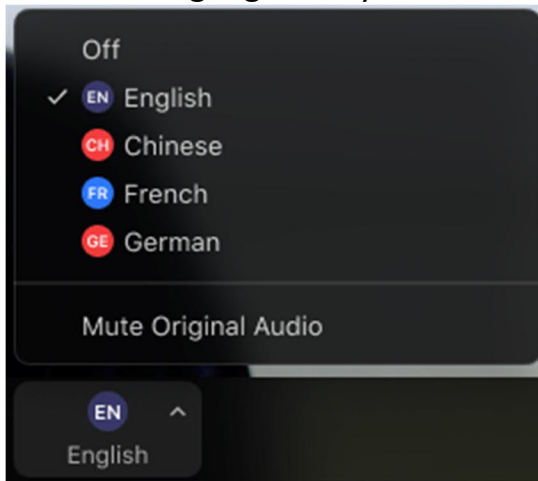
If you are using a computer running Windows or macOS, click on the button at the bottom of your Zoom window that says “**Interpretation.**” Then select the language that you would like to listen to. The choices will be English, Chinese, Spanish, and Korean. Since English will be the original language, if you want to switch from a non-English language and listen in English, select “Off.” Do not select “English.” See the screenshots below.



- In your meeting/webinar controls, click **Interpretation.**



- Click the language that you would like to hear.



- (Optional) To hear only the interpreted language and mute English, click **Mute Original Audio.**
- Click **Done.**

**Go to the next page for instructions for users of smartphones and tablets.**

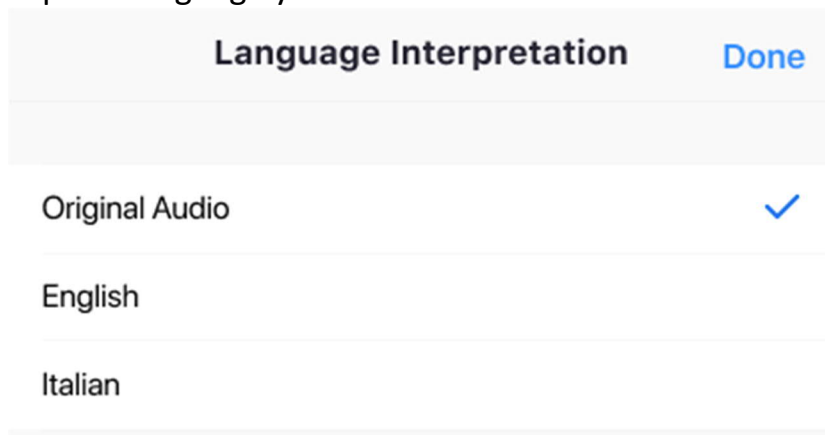
If you are using a smartphone or a tablet running Android or iOS, tap on the three dots at the bottom of your Zoom window that say “More.” Then tap “Language Interpretation” and select the language that you would like to listen to. The choices will be English, Chinese, Spanish, and Korean. Since English will be the original language, if you want to switch from a non-English language and listen in English, select “Original Audio.” Do not select “English.” See the screenshots below.
